Lego®-based Therapy

Lego®-based Therapy is a social development intervention for children with Autism Spectrum Disorders (ASD) and other difficulties impacting upon social competence. Social competence has consistently been seen to be an indicator of educational achievement. The original programme developers (led by Daniel B. LeGoff, a Paediatric Neuropsychologist) realised that children and young people responded to this form of therapy more positively than traditional forms of intervention and there was a noticeable improvement in social responsiveness and adjustment over relatively short duration. This course will give you the background knowledge, understanding and tools to be able to set up your own group or club.
